

FM Tour Guide Systems

Everyone wants to hear the tour guide clearly. But many older travelers suffer from partial hearing loss and miss much of what they came to enjoy. Now, you can add another level of value to your tour by adding an FM Tour Guide System.

The system works like a micro radio station. The tour leader wears a small transmitter with a noise canceling microphone; listeners wear a small receiver and ear speaker. The noise canceling mic blocks ambient sounds so only the leaders' voice is transmitted. Different channels permit multiple groups to operate in close proximity.
